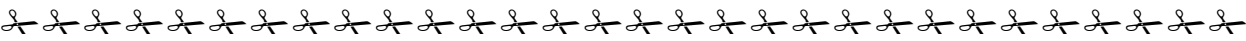

General Health & Safety Policy – Golf Course

General

- Players have an individual responsibility and a duty of care to behave in such a way that their actions do not harm themselves or others.
- Observe and adhere to all signage on the Course.
- Wear appropriate golf shoes for the conditions.
- All players must be aware of pedestrians using the public footpaths around the course and be prepared to shout “Fore” if a ball is struck towards them.

Playing

- DO NOT PLAY UNTIL the group ahead are out of range.
- DO NOT PLAY if staff are working close by or in range, wait for them to finish or move aside.
- Golfers who are waiting to play MUST do so in a safe place out of range of golf balls in play.
- When playing the 10th hole, Players MUST ring the bell on their way to the green.
- DO NOT PLAY from the 10th tee unless you have heard the bell from the group ahead or you know for certain that there is no group ahead.
- You MUST be prepared to shout “Fore” if you or your group has struck a ball towards another group.
- When a teeing area is close to a green, you MUST give priority to the group on the green before teeing off (i.e. 2nd Tee 17th Green, 11th Tee 10th Green).
- DO NOT PLAY to greens unless the green is clear.
- When playing near trees or fixed structures be aware of balls ricocheting.

Weather conditions

- Be aware of and comply with rules concerning cessation of play in dangerous weather conditions e.g. in poor visibility when the landing area of the ball is obscured DO NOT PLAY.
- In the event of fog or presence of lightning you MUST not play. Where possible, the course will be closed, or the hooter will be sounded by a member of staff to signify closure.
- If the course is open and the hooter has sounded play MUST be stopped immediately, players should mark their ball's position and return to the clubhouse until the fog OR lightning clears sufficiently and it is safe to play.
- If the hooter has not sounded or the course has not been officially closed this does not mean that it is safe to play. Players MUST consider their individual responsibility and duty of care in such circumstances.
- In the event of extreme weather conditions all players must ensure they are equipped appropriately with suitable clothing, footwear, headwear, sun cream and means of hydration.

Moving around the Course

- Where provided use artificial pathways.
- Where artificial pathways are not provided, use suitable worn or marked routes unless there are barriers to prevent access.
- Players MUST not walk or attempt to walk up or down banks that are outside of their limitations, either with or without a trolley.
- Buggy users MUST not use their buggies when conditions are too wet, muddy, or icy nor must they attempt to drive on banks at any time.
