



STANDARD OF DRESS & MOBILE PHONES

Members, guests and visitors are required to maintain a respectable standard of dress at all times both on the Course and in the Clubhouse. It is the responsibility of all members to ensure that this code of conduct is observed and that guests are aware of the requirements.

Any person offending the dress code will be informed accordingly and asked if they will familiarise themselves with the code and kindly conform to it on their next visit.

THE COURSE

Normal golfing clothes that are clean and tidy are acceptable. As a general guide, all clothes sold in golf professional shops are suitable and appropriate for wearing on the course.

Golf shoes must be worn at all times.

Shorts are permitted and ladies may wear “skorts”. Shorts must be fabric (not nylon or denim) that finish at knee height. Short white socks, sports “comfort” insert socks or long coloured socks must be worn with shorts.

The following items are not permitted:

Denim clothing, tee shirts, vests, track or shell suits, football shirts, Combat style trousers with pockets on legs, brief shorts or athletic shorts with an elasticated or draw string waist,

THE CLUBHOUSE (LOUNGE, BAR, RESTAURANT)

Casual clothing that is clean and tidy is permitted at all times. Muddy or dirty clothing is not acceptable.

The following items are not permitted:

CLOTHING: Beachwear, Vests, track suits of any kind, football shirts, brief shorts or athletic shorts with an elastic or draw string waist, and hats of any kind.

FOOTWEAR: Must be worn at all times; bare or stockinged feet and golf shoes of any kind are not acceptable.

FORMAL EVENTS

At any function designated as FORMAL, gentlemen are required to wear a jacket and tie and ladies are required to wear elegant attire.

MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones must be switched off or on silent mode on the course, in the bar, restaurant, and on the patio.

In the case of an emergency a mobile phone may be used anywhere.
